Federal funding; prohibiting acceptance of federal funds without certain financial plan. Emergency.
35. **SB 1994 By Dahm of the Senate and Echols of the House**  
Implementation of federal law; authorizing attorney general to enjoin certain actions; prohibiting the application for or acceptance of certain grants. Effective date.
36. **SB 2029 By Sykes of the Senate and Grau of the House (Proposed Comm. Sub., req. #3295)**  
Workers' compensation; clarifying reference. Effective date.
37. **SB 2071 By Sykes of the Senate and McBride of the House**  
Unlawful removal of objects; making it unlawful to take or remove certain objects from a disaster area; penalty. Effective date.
38. **SB 2084 By Burrage of the Senate and Sherrer of the House**  
Wrecker or towing services; modifying on what a certain assessment shall be predicated. Effective date.
