Schools; changing years during which school districts are exempt from certain requirements. Effective date. Emergency.

Schools; requiring certain financial report to be presented monthly to district boards of education. Effective date. Emergency.

Teachers; creating the Oklahoma Teacher Loan Forgiveness Program for certain teachers. Effective date. Emergency.
5. **SB 1036 By Smalley of the Senate (Proposed Comm. Sub., req. #3053)**
School personnel; modifying authority to designate school personnel allowed to carry firearms. Effective date. Emergency.

6. **SB 1105 By Ford of the Senate**
Subject matter standards; providing for students who have failed to meet certain requirements to re-enroll. Effective date. Emergency.
7. **SB 1157 By Bice of the Senate**
Higher education accreditation; requiring certain institutions to be accredited by certain agencies.
8. **SB 1264 By Jolley of the Senate and Martin of the House (Proposed Comm. Sub., req. #3099)**
Schools; requiring school districts to submit certain expenditure statements. Effective date.
9. **SB 1269 By Yen of the Senate and Martin of the House**
Education; directing the State Board of Education to develop certain certificate. Effective date. Emergency.
10. **SB 1312 By Sparks of the Senate**
School athletic associations; prohibiting certain participating schools from receiving state-appropriated funding. Effective date. Emergency.
11. **SB 1325 By Treat of the Senate**
Charter schools; removing language prohibiting charter schools from offering curriculum for deaf or blind students. Effective date. Emergency.
12. **SB 1350 By Ford of the Senate and Casey of the House (Proposed Comm. Sub., req. #3074)**
Teacher evaluations; providing for district evaluation ratings of teachers and leaders. Effective date. Emergency.
13. **SB 1423 By Griffin of the Senate**
Student transfers; allowing transfer students in certain grades to participate in activities. Effective date. Emergency.
