Office of Juvenile Affairs; directing the Office of Management and Enterprise Services to provide certain assistance. Effective date. Emergency.
9. **SB 1215 By Jolley of the Senate**
Commissioners of the Land Office property management; exempting CLO from certain acts; authorizing certain property purchases. Effective date. Emergency.
10. **SB 1262 By Jolley of the Senate**
Schools; directing the State Department of Education to establish certain language immersion pilot program. Effective date. Emergency.
