Insurance premium tax; establishing moratorium on ability to claim credits under certain circumstances. Effective date. Emergency.

Motor vehicle excise tax; modifying limitation on exemption for certain veterans. Effective date.
6. **SB 916 By Mazzei et al of the Senate**  
Income tax credits; modifying time period during which credits may be claimed for railroad reconstruction or replacement expenditures. Effective date.

7. **SB 1073 By Mazzei of the Senate and Nollan of the House (Proposed Comm. Sub., req. #3154)**  
Income tax; modifying provisions relating to reductions in top marginal income tax rates; requiring certain adjustment to taxable income. Effective date. Emergency.
8. **SB 1129 By Crain of the Senate**  
Ad valorem taxes; authorizing county treasurers to develop alternative method of, and schedule for, payment of certain ad valorem taxes. Effective date.
9. **SB 1240 By Mazzei of the Senate and Watson of the House (Proposed Comm. Sub., req. #3065)**  
Cities and towns; creating the Oklahoma Public Safety Protection District Act. Effective date.
10. **SB 1251 By Ford of the Senate and Caldwell of the House (Proposed Comm. Sub., req. #3066)**  
Sales and use tax; providing provisions for levying tax on certain sales. Effective date.
11. **SB 1252 By Floyd of the Senate (Proposed Comm. Sub., req. #3136)**  
Tax administration; requiring disclosure under Taxpayer Transparency Act of certain information of participants in PAYRight OK. Effective date.
12. **SB 1301 By Bice of the Senate (Proposed Comm. Sub., req. #3083)**  
Revenue and taxation; providing for collection of sales and use tax upon occurrence of certain circumstances. Effective date.
13. **SB 1315 By Brecheen of the Senate (Proposed Comm. Sub., req. #3158)**  
Public finance; authorizing use of State Bond Advisor by issuers of bonds for schools and municipalities. Effective date.
14. **SB 1338 By Shaw of the Senate and Cox of the House**  
Tax credits; requiring reauthorization of provision for credit for investments in clean-burning motor fuel property after certain review. Effective date.
15. **SB 1389 By Mazzei of the Senate and McCall of the House (Proposed Comm. Sub., req. #3161)**  
Securities; creating the Oklahoma Intrastate Crowdfunding Exemption. Effective date.
16. **SB 1393 By Allen of the Senate (Proposed Comm. Sub., req. #3084)**  
Income tax; modifying information required on certain returns; limiting tax credits under certain circumstances. Effective date.
17. **SB 1443 By Standridge of the Senate**  
Tax credits; requiring reauthorization of tax credit after evaluation by Incentive Evaluation Commission. Effective date.
18. **SB 1455 By Sharp et al of the Senate and Coody (Jeff) et al of the House**  
Ad valorem; specifying methodology for valuation of certain property related to lumber and building materials. Effective date.
19. **SB 1459 By Stanislawski of the Senate and Walker of the House**  
Motor vehicles; authorizing use of used dealer temporary license plates for certain nonprofit organizations. Effective date.

20. **SB 1484 By Jolley of the Senate**  
Sales and use tax; modifying tax rate and base after specified date; requiring Oklahoma Tax Commission to develop certain list. Effective date. Emergency.
21. **SJR 62 By Sparks of the Senate**  
Joint Resolution; use tax; expressing intent to collect use tax in this state if Courts or Congress act to compel out-of-state sellers to collect sales and use tax.
