The agency had been largely propped up by initial ARPA investment of \$6 million. That funding source expires in FY26. Agency would not be able to staff effectively to meet its required role with a 2% reduction.

Facing federal funding cuts from the Department of Labor, Department of Education and the Department of Health and Human Services will place a significantly higher burden on the state to fund job training, education and employer programs. The Commission will be needed to help determine the best usage of much more limited funding especially in a block grant senario and to better coordinate existing partners to maximize impact.
