## Second Regular Session of the Sixtieth Legislature of the State of Oklahoma

Seventh Legislative Day, Wednesday, February 11, 2026

The Senate was called to order by Senator Bullard.

Senator Coleman moved to amend **HB 1085**, Page 3, Line 16, by deleting after the word "after" and before the second comma, the date "January 1, 2026" and inserting the date "January 1, 2027"; Page 3, Line 23, by deleting after the word "after" and before the second comma, the date "January 1, 2027" and inserting the date "January 1, 2028"; Page 4, Line 6, by deleting after the word "after" and before the second comma, the date "January 1, 2028" and inserting the date "January 1, 2029"; and Page 4, Line 12, by deleting after the word "effective" and before the period, the date "January 1, 2026" and inserting the date "January 1, 2027", which amendment was declared adopted.
